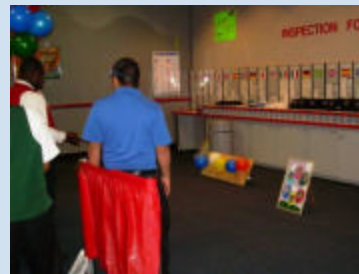
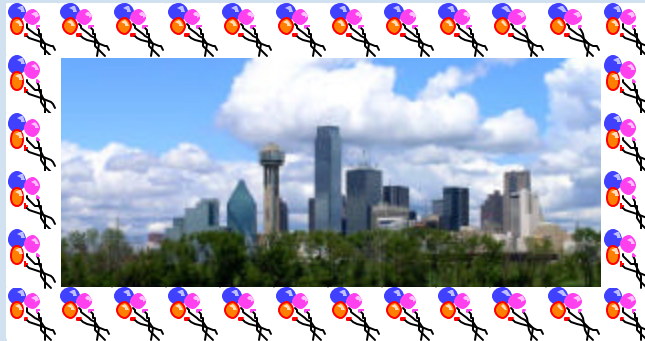
Tough Competition!

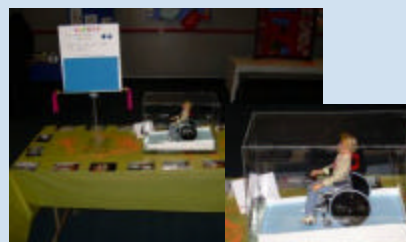
